Is there any other way?

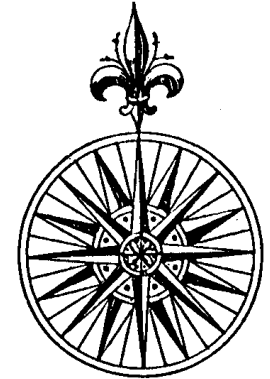
People may participate in any or all of the activities during the day. It will be a relaxed way to reconnect with everyone and share the stories of our Canoe Trails adventures.

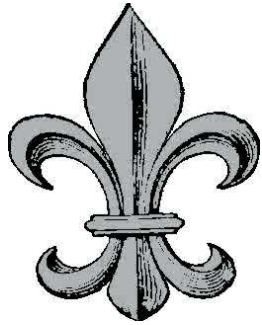
